An **Opening Reception** for the Auction Exhibition will be held on **Sunday**, **October 2 from 1pm to 4pm**. The reception is open to the public and free. Guests in attendance will be able to meet many of the participating artists, view the exhibition and bid on silent auction works. Guests who purchase auction tickets by October 2nd will be invited to **Brunch & Bid**, an exclusive auction preview party on October 2, 11am-1pm, where guests will have the first chance to bid in the Silent Auction gallery accompanied by brunch bites and champagne mimosas.

The Silent Auction & Party will be held on Saturday, October 8, 5pm – 8pm. This highly popular event features a vibrant mix of works in a variety of mediums that will excite novice and veteran art collectors alike. Artworks are available at all price points.
